

Dysynni 1 Newtown 4

Dysynni 1sts played hosts to Newtown ladies at the week-end. The match was fast and furious, and saw Dysynni go ahead against the flow of play after 10 mins. Rhian Lloyd having a strong game in midfield dribbled the ball up the pitch and put a great through ball to Catrin Davies to run onto and cross powerfully into the circle, where it deflected off the keeper and left Bethan Williams to pop it home with a neat reverse stick tap in.

Newtown fought back and for much of the first half, play was in the Dysynni defensive half of the pitch. Close marking and a very determined defence saw the visitors stopped, time and again. Two minutes front eh break, Newtown got the equaliser they had been hunting, with their centre half driving into the circle and slipping it right for a neat flick over the outstretched goalie.

After the break, it was another 15 mins of battling by both teams before the break came. Kath Charters had made many great saves for Dysynni, but was caught by a flick through a sea of legs in a goal side scramble, to make it 2-1. Newtown kept the pressure on but Jo Redman as central sweeper for Dysynni continually intercepted loose balls by Newtown and forced them away again. However, a high flick saw the third goal, and despite a spectacular overhead clearance by Dysynni defender Lynda Bennett, a fourth went in just before the end of the match from a short corner.
