

Dysynni 10      Bangor 2nds 0 and Dysynni 4 Pembroke 2

From the outset this NW League cup tie was one - way traffic, as Dysynni made amends for last week's crushing defeat at the hands of Colwyn Bay.

Straight into attack from the start, saw Bethan Williams taking on the Bangor keeper and being brought down in the circle, leaving the ball free, and with the umpire playing advantage, Kathy Iffla scooped it up, and planted it firmly in the back of the net for a first goal, all within 2 minutes of the start of play. Bangor struggled to reply, and soon a second goal came from a cross from winger, Catrin Davies, picked up by Williams, and put away cleanly, wrong footing the keeper.

Open play followed with a few forays by Bangor into the Dysynni defence, and some penalty corners won by the visitors. However, the home team defence held strong, and soon the forwards were attacking again, and a third goal was a home goal deflected round the keeper from a shot by Kathy Iffla. The pressure on Bangor was sustained by Dysynni right up until half time. Some lovely passing play by Briony Evans and Cassie Griffiths on the left side of the pitch repeatedly saw Bethan Williams being fed some good through balls, as she then added two more goals to her growing tally.

Bangor came out in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half determined to stop the rot. They attacked strongly, and began to dominate play for a while in the midfield, but were unable to convert this renewed strength into goals. Always vulnerable to the quick breaks by Dysynni, they were caught out in the 20<sup>th</sup> minute by a fine run up the pitch by Katie Latham, who shot, and as the keeper saved, Catrin Davies was there to lift the deflection neatly over the goalie's outstretched body. 2nd team captain, Carrie Bjugovic was then showing her strength and speed down the right and also converted two well made goals, before the irrepressible Williams finished off the game with 2 more goals, the last being an outrageous goal - dribbling cheekily past several defenders, and popping the ball in the back of net for her 5<sup>th</sup> and Dysynni's tenth.
