

## Hockey- Dysynni Men vs Colwyn Bay

In their inaugural fixture Dysynni Men turned in an emphatic 5-1 victory against North Wales League opposition Colwyn Bay. It was encouraging to see the number of junior players turning out for both sides. As the first half came to a close Dysynni made their dominance tell with goals from Iwan Lewis and a first time shot from Adrian Bennett from an excellent cross by Redmond.

The second half saw Colwyn Bay open the scoring within 5 minutes from an excellent reverse stick shot. The game was even for the rest of the half until a

long cross into the area from Dave Bowen was met emphatically with a wonderfully placed shot by Steve Bowen to cap the home sides' deserved win.

Man of the Match was Will Moeran for an excellent performance managing the Dysynni defence. Dysynni visit Colwyn Bay for the return fixture on 19<sup>th</sup> March and will be entering a team into the North Wales Men's League for the season 2006-07.
