

Dysynni 2 – 1 Colwyn Bay

The game took on an increased tempo now there was just the one goal in it again and Dysynni did well to hold off the visitors for the remaining 15 minutes.

Jamie Hooper played well on the left side creating several chances for the team. Ritchie Wall and Harry Davies coped well despite being amongst those having played two games in 48 hours.
