Dysynni 8 - 0 Llandudno

Dysynni entertained Llandudno in their first league match of 2007 and produced an excellent display of attacking hockey that produced an emphatic 8-0 victory for the home side. From the start of the match Dysynni pushed forward and in the second minute Tom Lewis picked up the ball and from a tight angle on the left to open the scoring. Ten minutes later Lewis scored his and Dysynni's second after some neat passing work from Brian Sellick and Dylan Jones.

Midway through the half Llandudno gave away a short corner and a well rehearsed move saw Brian Sellick return the ball to Stewart Langston who slotted home from the left. Dysynni were now in total control of the match with Trevor Humphries and debutant Keith Bartlett pushing up to support the midfield.

With ten minutes to go in the first half Dysynni added two more goals. The first of which saw Stewart Langston arriving late in the D to hit home a powerful drive. The goal of the match however came on the stroke of half time with a series of sharp passes leaving Brian Sellick in space in the D to lift a shot to the keepers left which was turned in by the ever youthful Dave Bowen.

Coach Phil Parton had some encouraging words for the team at half time. The second half saw Dysynni continue in an attacking vein with Shaun Redmond making some excellent runs on the wing linking up with the Dysynni forwards. Ten minutes into the half Dysynni added a sixth goal as skipper Adrian Bennett collected the ball in the D turned and deftly put the ball home through a crowd of players. Bennett poached a second soon after deflecting a drive by Dave Bowen into the corner of the goal. Dysynni's passing game proved too much for a young Llandudno side as Shaun Redmond tucked away the eighth goal of the game towards the end of the match. Man of the match for Dysynni was Keith Bartlett with an excellent display in his first game for the club in front of a crowd of 58 spectators.
