

Dysynni Mens Hockey: **Colwyn Bay 3-1 Dysynni 21st Oct 2006**

Dysynni men's team travelled to Colwyn Bay for their second fixture of the season. In sunny conditions the game got off to a fast and furious start with chances coming at both ends. Brian Sellick combined well with Stewart Langston in midfield to set up a number of forays into the Colwyn Bay half only to be thwarted by some solid defending. Mid way through the first half Colwyn Bay took the lead with Elliot Wilson collecting the ball on the Dysynni left and carrying it into the D where he drove the ball home for the first goal. The Dysynni defence with Jack Iffla and Ritchie Wall both outstanding in the first half held the Bays attack to one goal by half time.

Dysynni made a number of changes in the second half but to no avail as they went two nil down to a well worked move from a short corner that saw Chris Wright slot past Iestyn Richards. Mid way through the second half Dysynni made a breakthrough as a long corner found Adrian Bennett unmarked on the edge of the D. His sharp pass found man of the match Brian Sellick who slotted home from close range. The game then stepped up in tempo as both sides looked to add to their score with Dysynni's Tom Lewis coming close to equalising and Iestyn Richards keeping Dysynni in the game with a string of outstanding saves.

The second half was marred somewhat by two incidents the first being a green card for Dysynni keeper Richards as he inadvertently slid out of the D to play the ball. The second card was awarded to the Bays Joe Edwards for a deliberate trip on Stewart Langston and was lucky to stay on the pitch following an off the ball incident shortly afterwards.

The Bay however finally sealed victory with a second goal from Elliot Wilson off a last minute short corner. Final score – Colwyn Bay 3, Dysynni 1.
